<b>What to see:</b>	<p>Views of the planets through telescopes</p> <p>Talks and speakers scheduled every 2 hours</p> <p>Visual Sky guide with laser pointers</p> <p>Live streams from telescope webcams and cameras</p> <p>Live local Google+ broadcasts online via your smart phones</p> <p>Live international Google+ broadcasts online via your smart phones</p> <p>Meteors should start to appear around midnight</p> <p>Meteors storm could happen between midnight and sunrise</p> <p>Views of the Moon through the telescopes near dawn</p> <p>Moon and Venus conjunction just before dawn</p> <p>Watch the dawn break and sunrise into the Sky</p> <p>Join in with morning prayer in the desert</p>
